Lung cancer symptoms often appear in later stages, but early detection saves lives. A quick, painless low-dose CT scan can catch it early, using minimal radiation for detailed lung images, improving survival rates.

Are you eligible?

You may qualify for a low-dose CT lung cancer screening if you:

- Are aged 50-80
- Are a current smoker or have quit within the last 15 years
- Have a 20 pack-year smoking history (e.g., 1 pack per day for 20 years)

Note: Talk to your doctor to confirm your eligibility and determine if screening is right for you.

About the Low-dose CT scan.



A low-dose CT scan is a quick, painless 10-15 minute test that uses minimal radiation to capture detailed lung images. No special prep, injections, or dyes are needed. Your doctor will review the results shortly, allowing for early detection when treatment is most effective.

Most insurance plans cover lung cancer screening for eligible individuals.



Over 80% of lung cancers detected by low-dose CT scans are in the early stages, when treatment is most effective.



5-year survival rate for early-stage lung cancer is about 60%, compared to less than 10% for late-stage detection.
