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## How does - PAE work?

PAE is performed



without the risks associated with invasive surgery by our interventional radiologists subspecialty trained in vascular procedures. We use moderate sedation to keep you comfortable, while our doctor navigates a tiny catheter from an artery in your groin or wrist to the arteries supplying blood flow to the prostate. Tiny beads are then used to block the blood flow to the enlarged prostate, resulting in decreased size of the prostate. PAE has been proven to decrease and relieve the symptoms of BPH.

PAE may be a suitable option if you have moderate to severe benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH) symptoms and have not found relief from conservative treatments like medications and prefer a non-surgical solution.
